



Phonics Code Chart

Our phonics code chart is designed to assist teaching and be used alongside the introduction of alternative spellings within phase 5. You can print and enlarge the chart to add to your phonics display and then refer to the chart during phase 5 lessons. Additionally the chart can be printed and laminated in order to create a sound mat so that children can refer to it in order to support their writing within **English lessons and other** curriculum areas.

Within the code chart, you can find all of the most common alternative spellings for each of the phonemes, some of which will have been covered in other phases, whilst some are not covered until phase 5. We have chosen to not include rare and unusual alternative spellings as we feel these will be of little use to children at this stage. If they do crop up, you can always discuss the grapheme at the time. Naturally there will be some variations when it comes to accents, again, to be discussed with your children as these crop up.
